



COUNTRY-SIDE CHILDREN'S WELFARE HOME (CSCWH)

AWUTU BAWJIASE - GHANA

A Special Home for abandoned babies and children in the rural area of Ghana. These children are not only orphans but also have no extended families to go to as is the normal situation in Ghana. The Home receives no Ghana government funding but is managed and administered by Ghanaian volunteers, with donations from individuals, businesses, organizations, philanthropists. These Ghanaians are making sacrifices to make a difference in the life of these unfortunate African children in Ghana, where there are no free health care for children or childcare benefits.

Channel of Blessings

Children are gifts from God and the basis of our very survival. Not all are privileged to go through life normally; therefore, assistance and love for the less fortunate ones in the society can make a great difference. You can support the Home in several ways: by donating money (any amount is appreciated), by sending books in English, basic clothing (light/summer) and materials to the Home, **being a volunteer** at Awutu Bawjiase in Ghana to help take care of the children, the school or the farm (accommodation is provided free of charge for all volunteers) or just by telling other people about the Home/soliciting for financial and material support for these unfortunate children.

Preamble

The Country-side Children's Welfare Home (Bawjiase Orphanage) seeks to meet the needs of needy children, to provide them with a future as God provides the resources through mankind.

Country-Side orphanage is an independent, charitable, non-profit, non-governmental organization dedicated to the positive development and the welfare of under privileged children in the Ghanaian society.

It was established in the year 1981 by Madam Emma Bofo Yeboah through an inspiration by an American missionary couple at Winneba in the Central part of Ghana.

It was dully registered with the Registrar General Department and the Department of Social Welfare and received the Certificate of Recognition and Incorporation in the year 1994 and 1998 respectively.

The orphanage is located at the Eastern outskirts of Bawjiase Township on Bawjiase-Kasoa road. It is about 60 Kilometers away from Accra, the capital city of Ghana and about 25 minutes drive from Agona Swedru. There is a regular movement of cars connected to both of these places.

Bawjiase as a community center has a population of about 18, 000, including its surroundings. It has a market twice a week on Tuesdays and Fridays. You are sure of almost everything needed in life.

Currently, children population stands at 120, age range from one week old babies to over twenty years.

Our Accomplishments

The Home has good records of survival of all the abandoned babies sent from the department of Social Welfare, Police and elsewhere, many of whom arrived in critical conditions as these babies were left unattended to for days.

The Home's Preparatory School offers excellent tuition for all the inmates and some children from Bawjiase community. The Home also offers basic education for the inmates up to the Junior Secondary School (JSS) level.

Basic needs such as food, clothing, shelter, entertainment, and others are being provided for over hundred and fifty inmates of the Home. Since the Home receives no funds or financial support from the Government of Ghana, it relies on the support and donations from individuals, churches and organizations to provide these basic needs for these children

May God bless and reward all who have helped and continue to help in diverse ways.

Aims & Objectives

- To create a comfortable home for the inmates
- The establishment of a basic school and Junior Secondary School. A Vocational Training Institute is paramount. These will serve the inmates and the community as well.
- To go into vegetables, poultry and livestock farming in order to supplement the nutritional needs of the children. These will also generate income for the running of the Home.
- To open a mini shop to sell the farm products and handicrafts from the inmates of the orphanage
- To unite all the inmates of the home into a big Christian family
- To provide decent accommodations for all these abandoned children who come into the care of the Home.
- Try our best to install self-esteem, hope and give proper future for the inmates of the Home.
